

NPH COVID Policy and Waiver of Liability

COVID Policy

The Non-Profit Housing Association of Northern California (NPH) is excited to connect in-person. The health and safety of all participants is our top priority.

To protect our community:

- 1. We require guests to stay at home if they test positive for COVID-19, have COVID-like symptoms, or have recently been exposed.
- 2. We **encourage guests to wear an KN95, KF94, or N95 mask** while not actively eating or drinking.

In the event that the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)</u> and/or the <u>City and County of San Francisco</u> adopt more cautionary guidelines, we'll adjust our policy in accordance.

Face Covering

NPH encourages all indoor participants to wear masks throughout the event while not actively eating or drinking. Face coverings must be a well-fitting KN95, KF94, or N95 mask and completely cover the nose and mouth with no large gap.

Attendees are expected to bring their own masks. A limited number of masks will be available on-site.

Symptoms and Exposure

Attendees are required to stay at home if they:

- Are currently testing positive for COVID-19 on the event date,
- Have been in close contact with anyone who tested positive for COVID-19, or who
 have had COVID-19 symptoms within the last 5 days (according to CDC)
- Are experiencing any new or different symptoms that are not related to a
 pre-existing condition such as: Fever, Cough, Severe headache, Sore throat, Loss of
 taste or smell, Difficulty breathing/Shortness of breath, Vomiting/Nausea or
 Diarrhea, Runny nose, or Fatigue or Body Aches

If you are unable to attend the event due to possible exposure, you may be eligible for a full or partial refund (only applicable for ticketed events).

Respecting Others' Space

NPH asks all participants to respect everyone's physical boundaries and comfort level by requesting and receiving consent before touching another participant.

COVID Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability

Despite precautions taken, NPH cannot ensure that you will not be exposed to or contract COVID-19 as a result of participating in this event or related activities. By registering/attending this event, you acknowledge and understand all risks associated with possible exposure to and contraction of COVID-19, and are voluntarily participating in the event for your own benefit, the value of which is sufficient consideration for your voluntary execution of this agreement.

You further acknowledge that you understand and assume the risk that exposure to and contraction of COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of yourself and others, including, but not limited to, NPH employees, officers, representatives, agents, and any others present at the NPH event(s). Additionally, you agree to release and hold harmless NPH and its employees, officers, representatives, and agents from any and all alleged and/or actual liability, claims, actions, lawsuits, damages, or losses of any kind which arise out of or result from attendance at and participation in NPH event(s).

You understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of NPH, its employees, officers, representatives, or agents. Attendee agrees to release and hold harmless NPH and its employees, officers, representatives, and agents from any and all claims, demands, and causes of action arising out of or relating to your participation in the event you are registering to participate in and use of any associated facilities or hotels. If any provisions contained in this agreement shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, under any applicable law, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not, in any way, be affected or impaired.
